IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

Councilmember Tommy Wells introduced the following bill which was referred to the
Committee on _____.

To amend chapter 24 of Title 18 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations to
allow overnight parking in residential permit parking areas within ten (10) feet or
more of an intersection.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF CLOUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Residential Overnight Parking Enhancement
Amendment Act of 2010.”

Sec. 2. Chapter 24 of Title 18 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations
is amended as follows:

(a) Section 2411.21 is amended to read as follows:

“Vehicles displaying a valid residential parking permit may park within a
designated residential permit parking zone in the following manner, except at
intersections where the Director of the District Department of Transportation has
determined such parking would be inappropriate and unsafe or where such parking is
prohibited as provided in § 2405:

(a) Between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:30 a.m. within ten (10) feet or more of
the intersection; and

1 (b) At all other times within twenty-five (25) feet or more of the intersection.”

2 (b) Section 2405.2(d) is amended by striking the semicolon at the end and
3 inserting a comma, followed by the phrase “except as provided in 2411.21(a);”.

4 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

5 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the
6 fiscal impact statement required by section 602 (c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home
7 Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Code §1-233(c)(3)).

8 Sec. 4. Effective date.

9 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto
10 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of
11 Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home
12 Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-
13 206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.
