SUBJECT: REQUEST BOARD OF DIRECTORS APPROVAL FOR PROPOSED BUS SERVICE CONSIDERATIONS

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WASHINGTON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSIT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, Metrobus has established criteria to determine service effectiveness, including average ridership per day, passengers per revenue trip, passengers per revenue mile, subsidy per passenger, and cost recovery; and

WHEREAS, Service adjustments to provide more efficient service are periodically needed, including additional trips on crowded routes, additional trips to extend service later in the evening, additional running time on trips that are consistently late, and additional Saturday or Sunday service to areas with the greatest demand; and

WHEREAS, Staff is reviewing an approach to service realignment that would not increase operating costs and not require additional buses, but would increase ridership, increase the farebox recovery ratio, and maintain or improve overall on-time performance and customer satisfaction; and

WHEREAS, Approval of the Customer Service and Safety Committee and the Board of Directors is necessary to take actions, including meeting the public hearing requirement, to modify bus services to improve service efficiency and customer satisfaction; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That, in accordance with Section 62 of the WMATA Compact, the Board of Directors will conduct a series of public hearings to solicit public comment on the service change proposals listed on Attachment A as requiring a public hearing; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Board of Directors will also receive comments on the service change proposals listed on Attachment A as not requiring a public hearing; and be if further

RESOLVED, That the Board of Directors expressly reserves judgment on whether any of the proposed service changes are appropriate or justified; and be it further

RESOLVED, That Staff is directed to develop and place on the Metro website a means to obtain comments electronically with such comments being in addition to comments

obtained in writing, by e-mail or in person and which shall become part of the public record of the hearing; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Board of Directors authorizes the General Manager to report on the findings of the public hearings and that the Board of Directors shall consider these findings and public comments in connection with any decisions on the service changes being proposed; and be it further

RESOLVED, That if there are any financial savings resulting from the service reductions being proposed they are to be redirected to areas of the greatest need; and be it finally

RESOLVED, That this Resolution shall be effective immediately.
