Add a new subtitle to Title I to read as follows:

Sec. xxx1. Short title.

This act may be cited as the Washington Convention Center Amendment Act of 2012”.

Sec. xxx2. Section 207 of the Washington Convention Center Authority Act of 1994, effective September 28, 1994 (D.C. Law 10-188; D.C. Official Code ' 10-1202.07), is amended by adding a new subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

“(b-1)(1) The Chief Executive Officer of the Washington Convention and Sports Authority (“WCSA”) shall personally distribute Washington Nationals Baseball tickets, and parking passes, to the Mayor, the Chairman of the Council and each Councilmember for the entire season and post season as follows:

“(A) Of the 38 tickets for the box for each game:

“(i) Eight tickets to the Mayor;

“(ii) Four tickets to the Chairman of the Council; and

“(iii) Twenty-four tickets to the other Councilmembers, 2 tickets to each Councilmember per game;

“(B) Of the 25 tickets for the lower bowl:

“(i) Eleven tickets to the Mayor;

“(ii) Two tickets to the Chairman of the Council; and

“(iii) Twelve tickets to the other Councilmembers, on an alternating basis so that each Councilmember receives 2 tickets for every other game;

“(C) Of the 25 parking passes, for each game:

“(i) Nine passes for the Mayor;

“(ii) Four passes for the Chairman; and

“(iii) One pass each to the other Councilmembers.

“(2) The 2 boxes at the Verizon Center provided to the District each contain 18 seats, and the Chief Executive Officer of the WCSA shall personally distribute to each individual the Verizon Center tickets for each seat for all events to the Mayor, the Chairman, and each Councilmember as follows:

“(A) For one of the boxes, the Chairman, 4 at-large members, and Ward 1-4 Councilmembers shall each receive 2 tickets to every event; and

“(B) For the other box, the Mayor shall receive 10 tickets to every event and Ward 5-8 Councilmembers shall receive 2 tickets each to every event.

Rationale: This amendment shall provide clarity for distribution of tickets.
