Please find enclosed the "Automated Traffic Enforcement Moratorium Act of 2013". This Act was filed today with the Secretary of the Council of the District of Columbia.

I have been working on this proposed legislation for a while with the intent to file it on July 10, 2013 at our next scheduled legislative session. However, I felt compelled to file it today in light of recent declarations.

The members of the Council of the District of Columbia are well aware of the issues surrounding the DC automated enforcement system. As you know, any bill we pass goes to Congress for a 30-day review period. With the filing of the proposed legislation today, it would be appropriate to let the legislative process proceed. If this legislation proceeds through the Council and is signed by the Mayor, it will then come to Congress for review. I trust that you would agree that this would be the appropriate time for you to weigh in.
